How to book a yacht?

There are two ways to book a boat. If you are not sure what you want and this is your first time renting a boat, it would be best to call us or send us an email with all the necessary information. This information includes the number of people on board, departure point, boat rental and all possible requirements. We will contact you with an offer for you. After confirming your reservation, you will be required to pay 50% of the rental price, while the rest of the amount should be covered four weeks before the start of the charter. In addition to the basic board booking services, we can also offer you the organization of transfers, additional equipment, hostess or similar.

If you know what kind of boat you want to rent, you can consult our database and send us the exact request in relation to a particular boat or period. Then follow the above procedures.

What is APA in yacht charter?

APA stands for Advanced Provisioning Allowance. APA is an additional fee that will cover all additional costs, such as food, drinks, fuel, mooring costs, special requirements ... APA is applied, as a standard on most professional yacht charters, and is close to mandatory for all luxury yacht charters.

The APA is usually calculated as a percentage of the rental fee, which you then pay as a supplement before the start of the rental. The amount varies from yacht to yacht, but is usually between 30% and 40% of the yacht rental fee.

Arrival at the base - Login (Check-in)

The long-awaited moment has arrived when your vacation on a chartered boat begins. Upon arrival at your destination, you must arrive at the charter base where the boat is waiting for you.

Regular check-in is scheduled from 17:00hrs.

Getting to the charter base at the agreed time is very important, as you probably won't be the only guests who need to take your boat during the day. If you happen to arrive earlier than expected, you can visit the city or have lunch. You can also go to the store. However, if you happen to be late, let the base know so that the charter base staff knows when they can expect you.

Don't forget your documents. You must have a passport or ID card for all persons who will be staying on the vessel, that the registration of the crew list can be done, and the sojourn tax must be paid. It is a legal requirement that crew lists be sent to the Croatian Ministry of Maritime Affairs, and every charter ship in Croatian waters must have them. Also, you can request the form by e-mail, and fill it in to the Charter database beforehand, so that you can receive a ready list of crew.

Check out

After spending time enjoying the sea, the sun and the beauties of the Adriatic, it is time to return to the harsh reality. The first thing you need to agree with the captain is the return time. Regular check out is scheduled at 09:00hrs. Depending on your wishes, you can return to the base in the evening, the day before departure. Of course, you have the right to spend the night on board, and leave the boat by 09:00 in the morning.

Once the check-out process is complete, you can leave the charter base.
